

Privacy Policy

Welcome to Fastapp, Inc. ("Fastapp", "we", "us", or "our"). We operate the website www.fastapp.com (the "Service") and are committed to protecting the privacy and security of our users' ("you", "your") information. This Privacy Policy informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of personal data when you use our Service and the choices you have associated with that data.

By accessing, browsing, or utilizing our website, you confirm that you have read, understand, and consent to the practices described in this policy, agreeing to adhere to its terms.

Your privacy is a priority at Fastapp. We are dedicated to safeguarding your privacy and earning your trust. We uphold your right to keep your personal information private and to avoid undesired solicitations. Engaging with this website, including the services or information it provides, signifies your acceptance of this policy and any applicable terms.

Collection of Information

Personal Information

Fastapp values your privacy and is committed to protecting personally identifiable information you may provide during your interaction with our website and services. We collect information that personally identifies users when they submit service requests, create user accounts, or provide information in other forms on our website.

Additionally, we gather nonpublic personal information related to your agreements, applications, or transactions with us. This may include data aggregated from your inputs or collected through cookies, pixel tags, web beacons, browser fingerprinting, or similar technologies. The information varies by your website usage, the services you inquire about or select, and encompasses:

- Information from forms, applications, or agreements
- Transaction details with us, our affiliates, or others
- User account creation and service interest data
- Interaction with our website and online behavior
- Reports from consumer agencies and other sources
- With consent, details from third-party verifications related to your transactions
- Non-Personally Identifiable Information

Log Data and Cookies

We collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our Service ("Log Data"). This Log Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol (IP) address, browser

type, browser version, the pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, and other statistics.

If you prefer not to accept cookies, you may set your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some portions of our Service effectively.

Use of Data

Fastapp uses the collected data for various purposes:

- To provide and maintain our Service
- To notify you about changes to our Service
- To allow you to participate in interactive features of our Service when you choose to do so
- To provide customer care and support
- To provide analysis or valuable information so that we can improve our Service
- To monitor the usage of our Service
- To detect, prevent, and address technical issues

Sharing of Data

We may employ third-party companies and individuals to facilitate our Service ("Service Providers"), to provide the Service on our behalf, perform Service-related services, or assist us in analyzing how our Service is used. These third parties have access to your Personal Information only to perform these tasks on our behalf and are obligated not to disclose or use it for any other purpose.

Security of Data

The security of your data is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

Links to Other Sites

Our Service may contain links to other sites that are not operated by us. If you click a third-party link, you will be directed to that third party's site. We have no control over and assume no responsibility for the content, privacy policies, or practices of any third-party sites or services.

California Privacy Rights

In accordance with the California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA) and other California privacy laws, residents of California have specific rights regarding their personal information. This section describes your CCPA rights and explains how to exercise those rights.

Right to Know and Data Portability

You have the right to request that Fastapp discloses certain information to you about our collection and use of your personal information over the past 12 months. Once we receive and confirm your verifiable consumer request, we will disclose to you:

- The categories of personal information we collected about you.
- The categories of sources for the personal information we collected about you.
- Our business or commercial purpose for collecting or selling that personal information.
- The categories of third parties with whom we share that personal information.
- The specific pieces of personal information we collected about you (also called a data portability request).

Right to Delete

You have the right to request that Fastapp delete any of your personal information that we collected from you and retained, subject to certain exceptions. Once we receive and confirm your verifiable consumer request, we will delete (and direct our service providers to delete) your personal information from our records, unless an exception applies.

Right to Opt-Out

You have the right to opt out of the sale of your personal information. Fastapp does not sell personal information.

Non-Discrimination

We will not discriminate against you for exercising any of your CCPA rights. Unless permitted by the CCPA, we will not:

- Deny you goods or services.
- Charge you different prices or rates for goods or services, including through granting discounts or other benefits, or imposing penalties.
- Provide you a different level or quality of goods or services.
- Suggest that you may receive a different price or rate for goods or services or a different level or quality of goods or services.
